ST. GERMAIN

Hendrick's Gin and St. Germain stirred and served straight up with a cucumber slice 10.

WHITE WHISKEY MANHATTAN

Deaths Door White Whiskey, Royal Combier, orange bitters, stirred and served straight up 10.

GRAPE DOMAINE

Ciroc Vodka, St. Germain, splash of fresh lemon juice muddled grapes, Domaine St. Michelle float 10.

BASIL GIMLET

Choice of Hendricks Gin or Ketel One Vodka mixed with basil and fresh lime juice, splash of simple syrup served chilled and straight up 10.

WHISKEY SMASH

Makers Mark, muddled orange, fresh citrus-mint syrup and Lillet Blanc, served on the rocks 10.

POMEGRANATE MOJITO

Bacardi Limon, pomegranate juice, fresh lime juice, mint leaves, simple syrup, soda water served over crushed ice 9.

WATERMAN COSMOPOLITAN

SVEDKA Citron, Cointreau, fresh squeezed lime and splash of cranberry served straight up 10.

WATERMAN SANGRIA

Our house Sangria recipe finished with red or white wine and fresh fruit 8. / 26.

WATERMAN DOLI

House-made pineapple infused vodka, shaken well served on the rocks 8.50

MARGARITA LUNAZUL

Lunazul Anejo Tequila, Royal Combier, Agave Nectar, fresh citrus served on the rocks with a salted rim 9.

BACARDI DOBLE

Bacardi Dragon Berry, and Torched Cherry, Cointreau, splash of simple syrup and grapefruit juice served over crushed ice 9.

GINGER PEAR

Double Cross vodka, Domaine de Canton ginger liqueur, fresh lemon juice, clover honey and pear puree, served straight up, baby Chilean pear garnish 11.
